PANGOLIN 10 Wild Facts

- There are **8 species** of Pangolin - 4 in Asia and 4 in Africa
- Pangolins are very unique as they are **mammals with scales** instead of fur
- Pangolin scales are made of **keratin**, the same as human fingernails
- Pangolins have long, **strong claws** for digging
- Pangolins eat only **ants and termites**
- Pangolins have very **long, sticky tongues** - as long as their head and body combined!
- Most Pangolins are **solitary** - spending most time on their own
- Most Pangolins are **nocturnal** - active at night
- Pangolin babies are called **pups**. At one year old they leave their burrows, hitching a ride on their mother's tail
- The main threat to the Pangolin species is **poaching** for their scales













EXPLORE MORE!
